Guatemala 2014 Recap

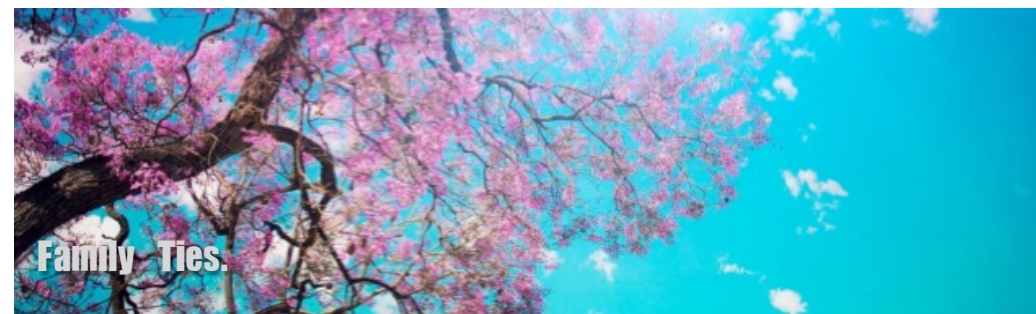

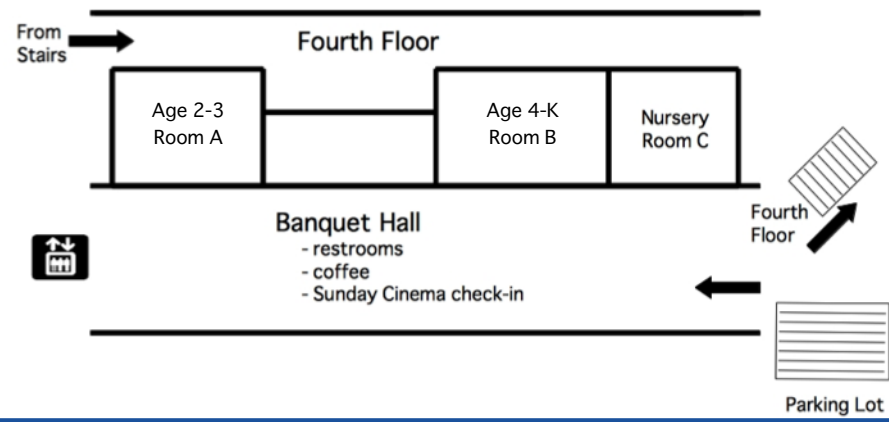

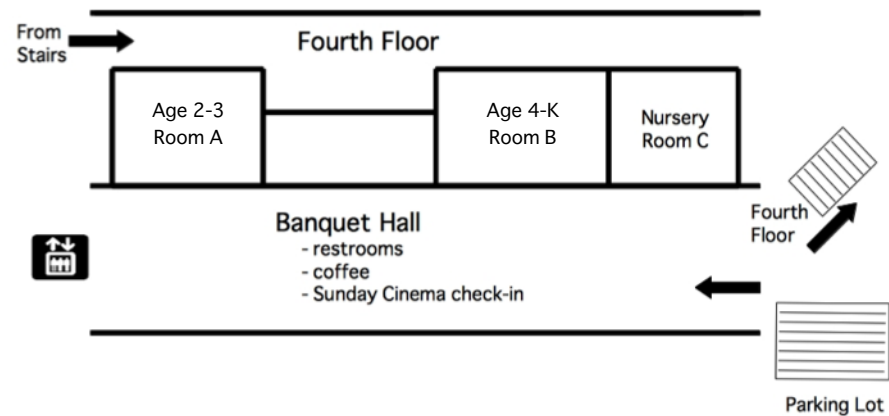
