Next Sunday: Listening Prayer

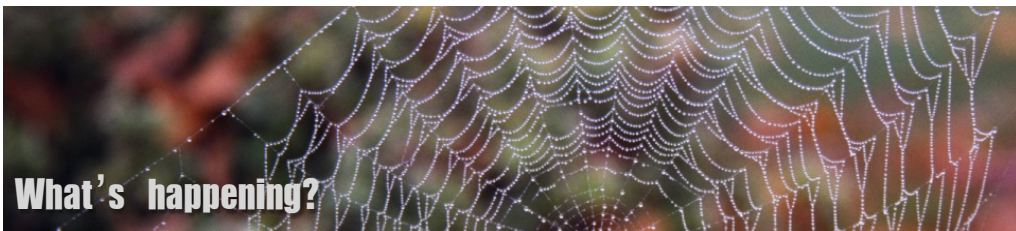
