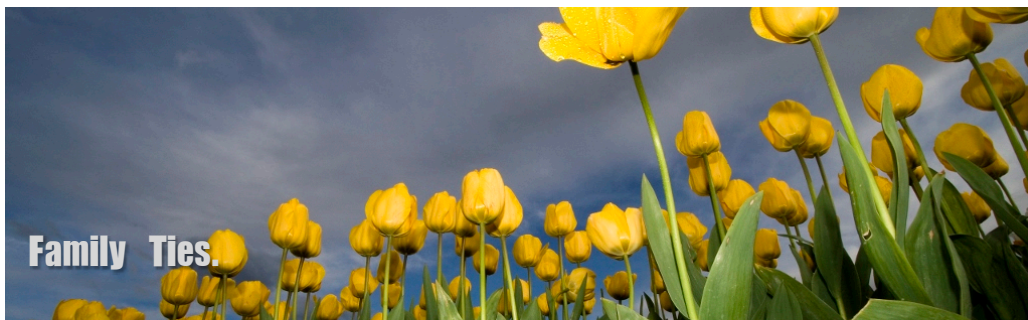

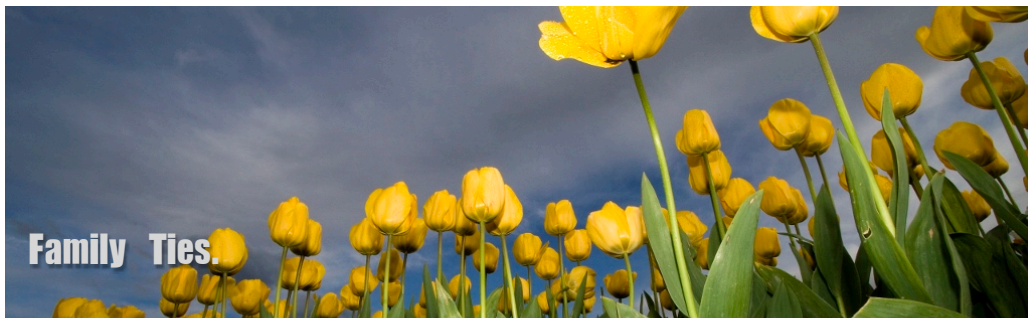
Go Big: God in Action

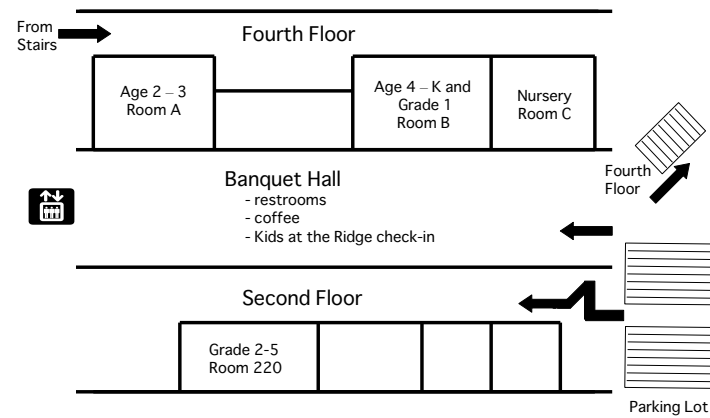

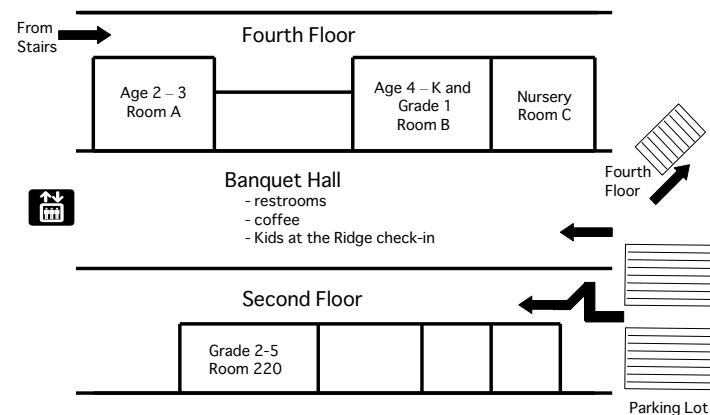
