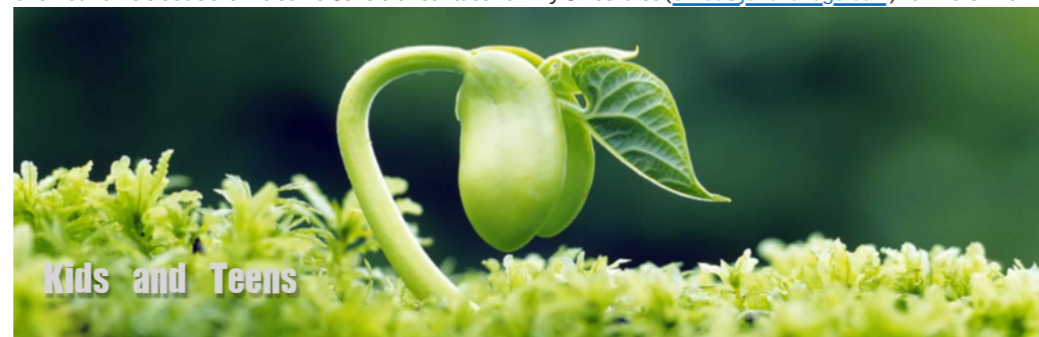
Youth Service at Nights Alive

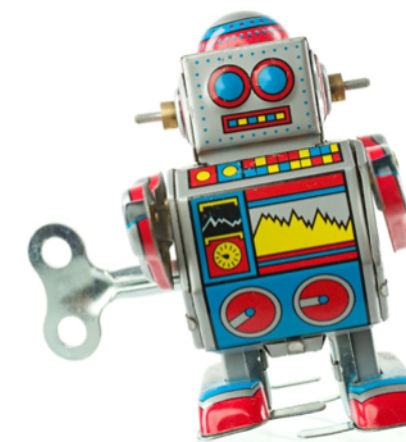

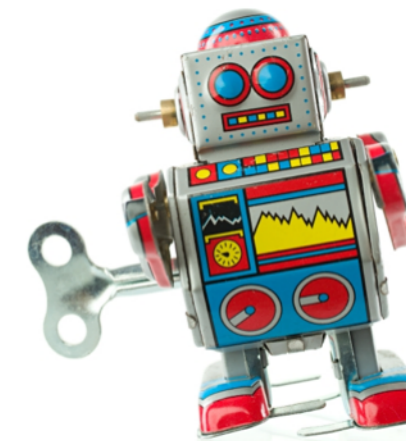
