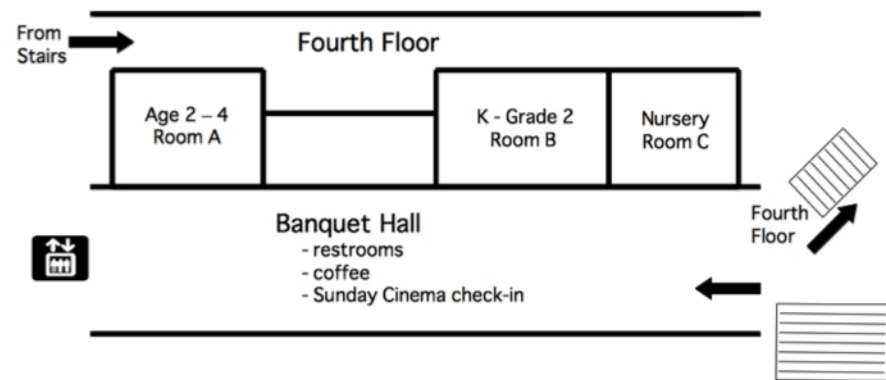

JRCC's Anti-Spam Protocol






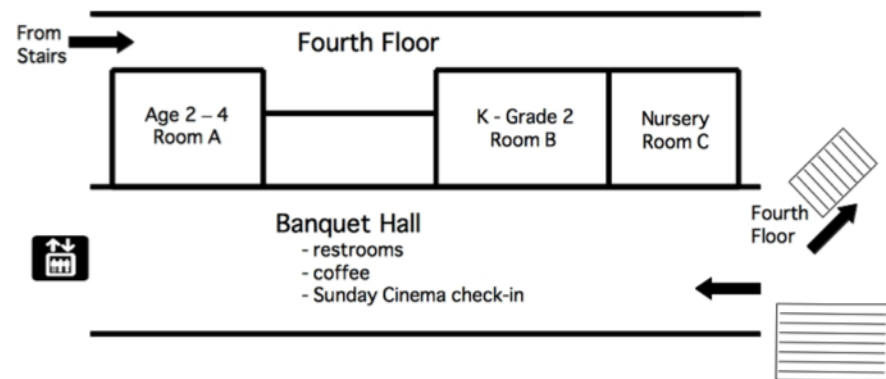
