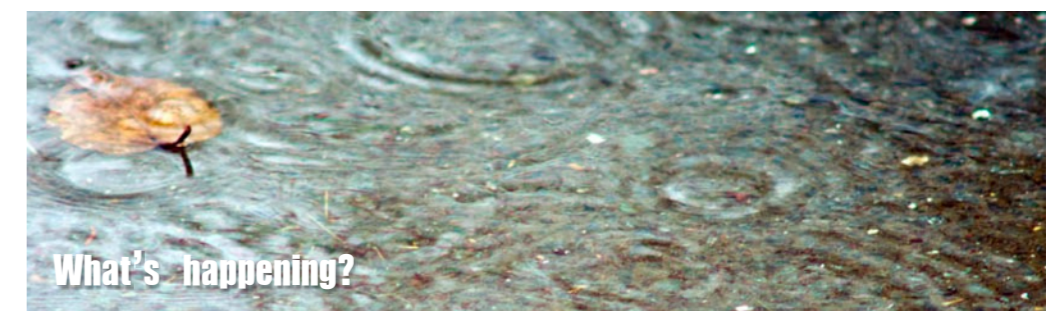

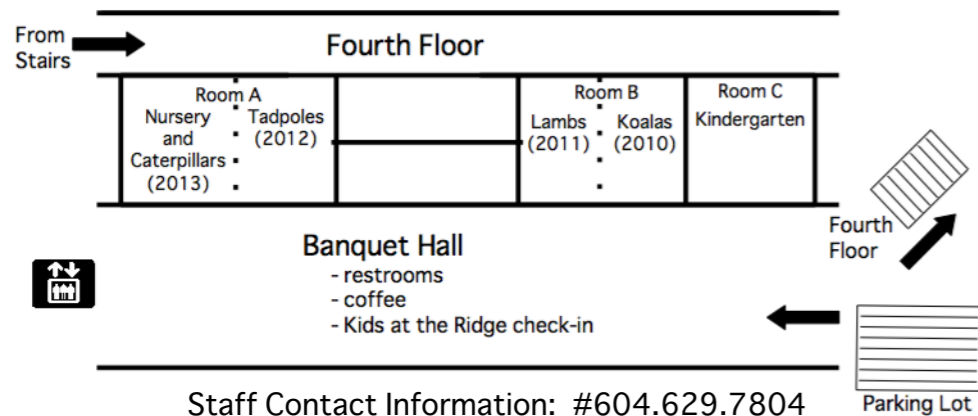

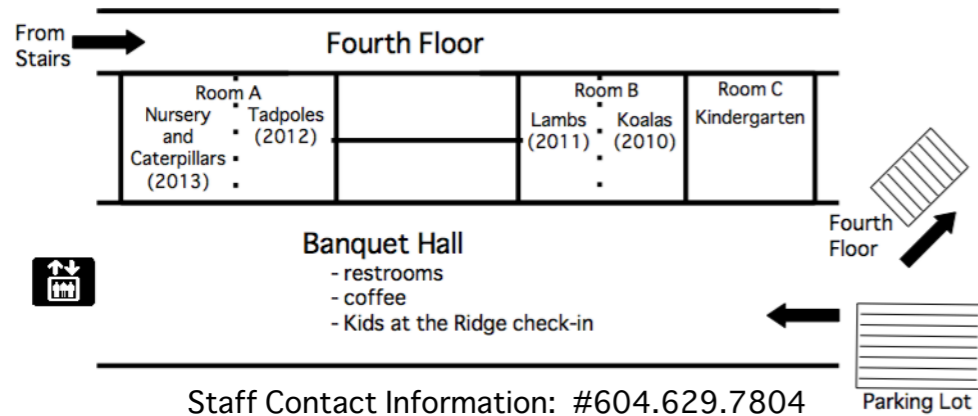
Where are our Youth?

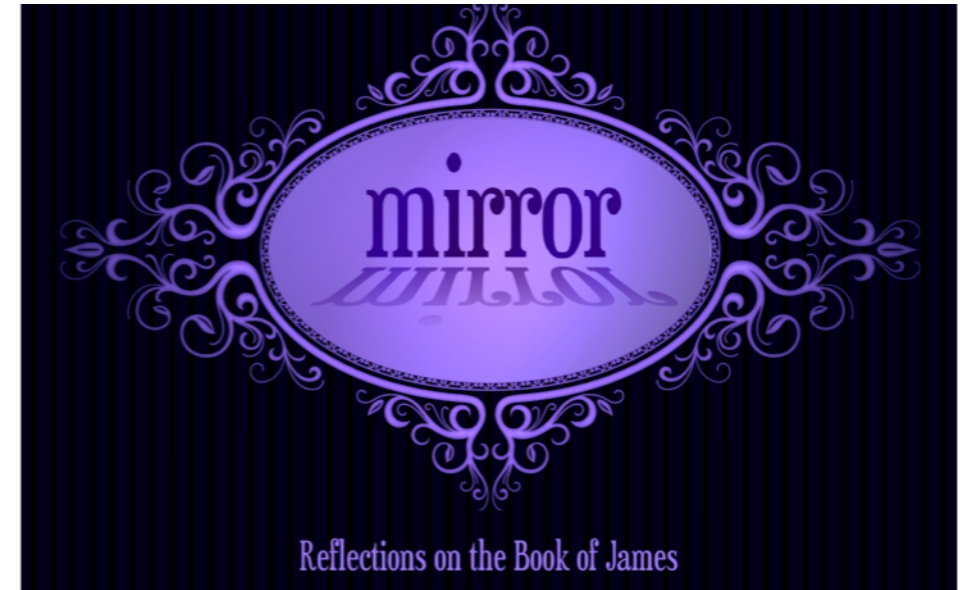
