### Vision Night – Nov 27

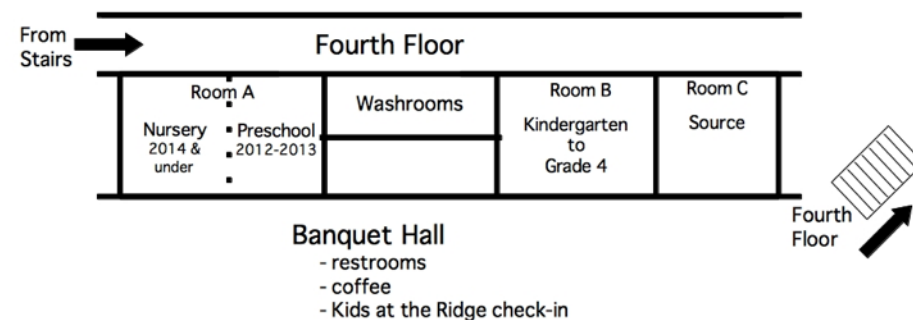

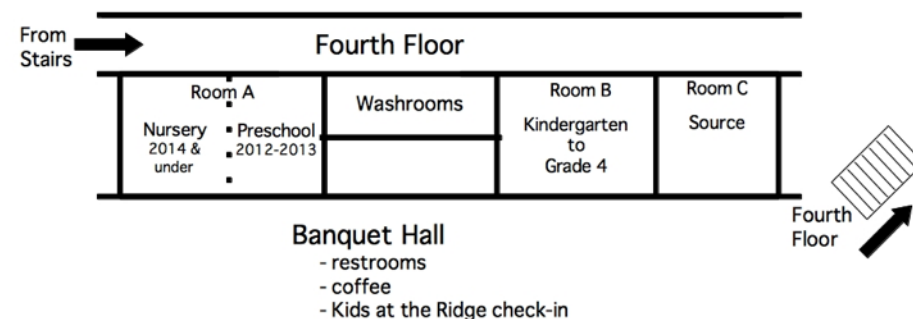
