Haney to Harrison Run

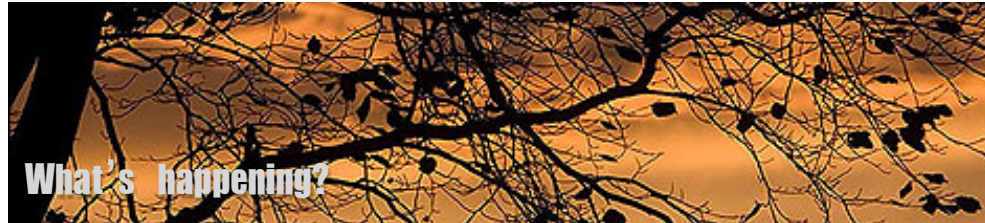

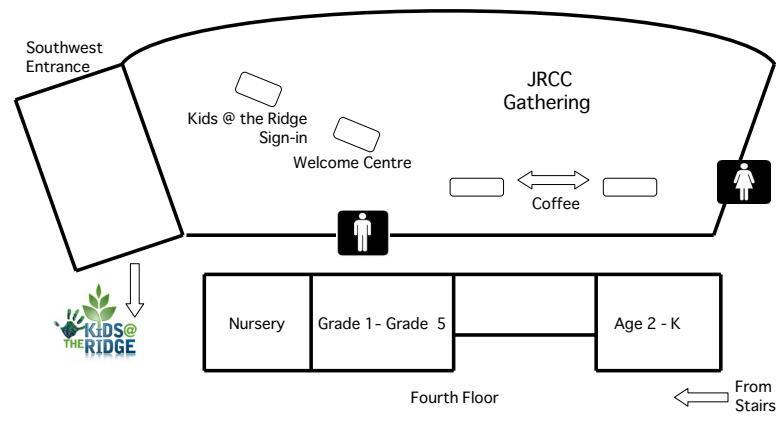

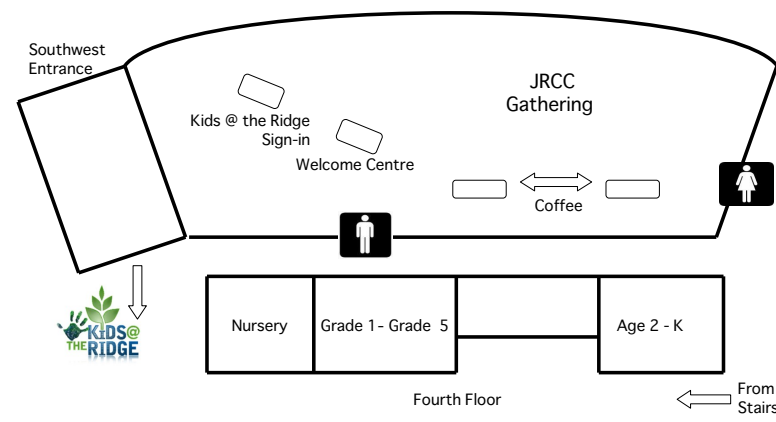
