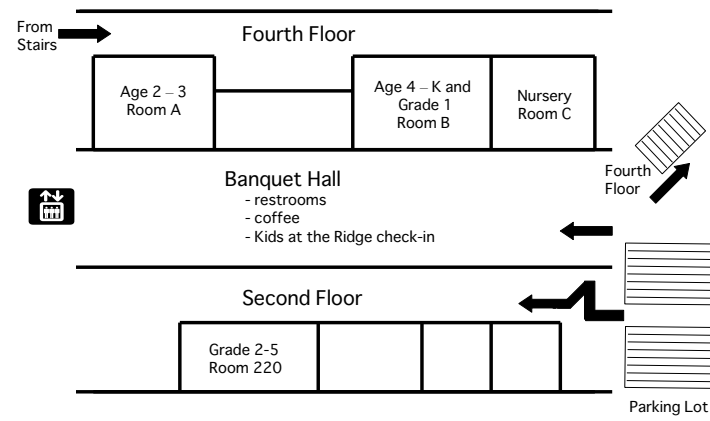

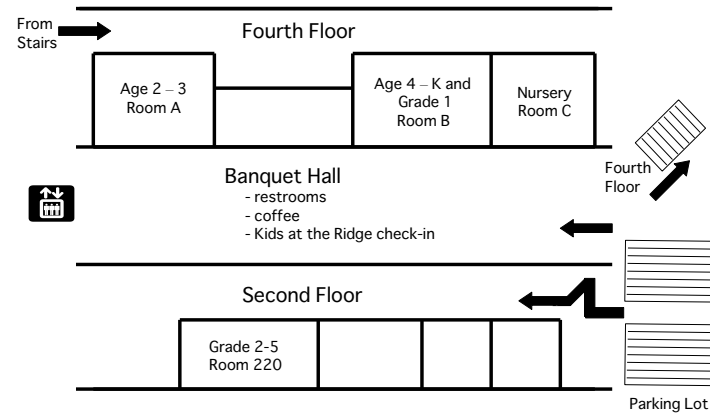

Fusion at the Walnut Grove Pool

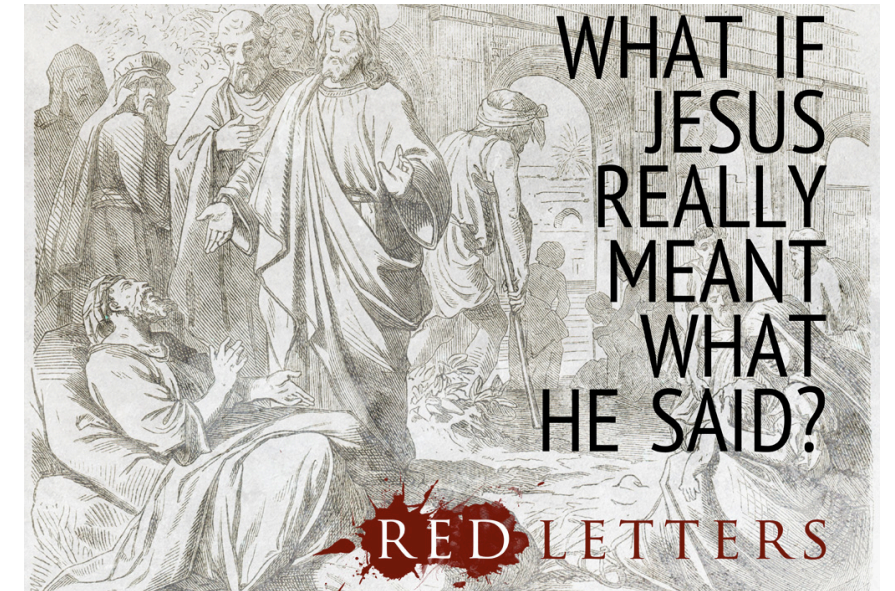
