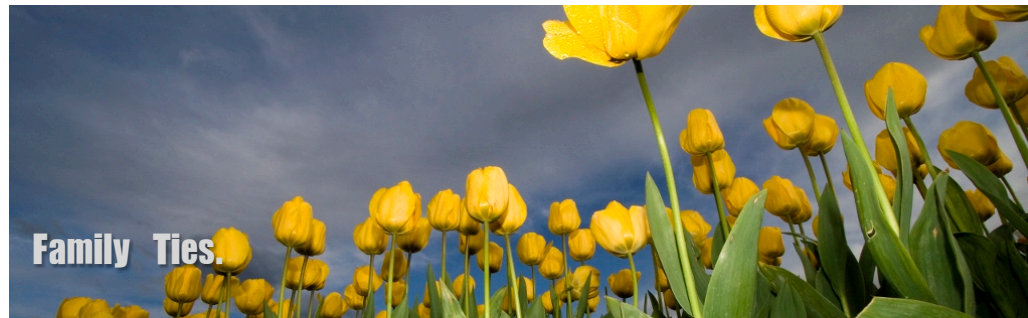

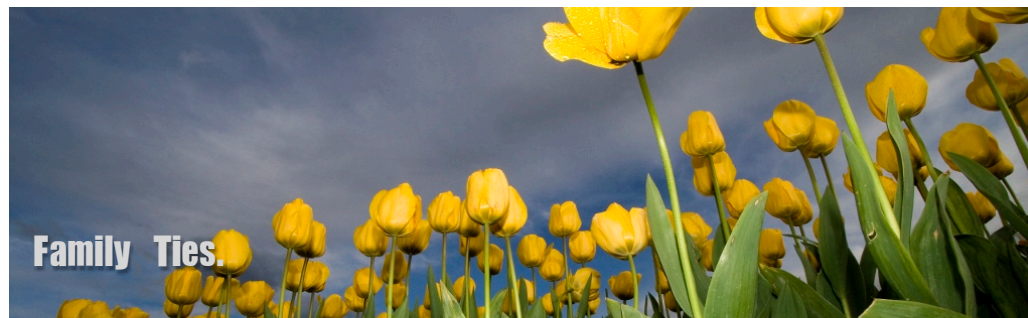
Communion & Benevolence Sunday

Refresh Playdate – Wednesday

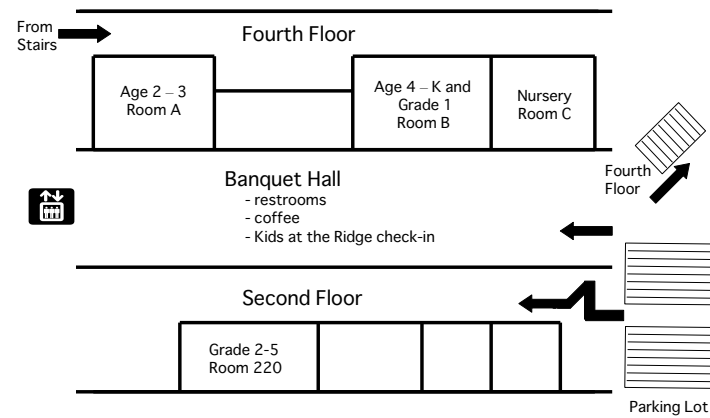

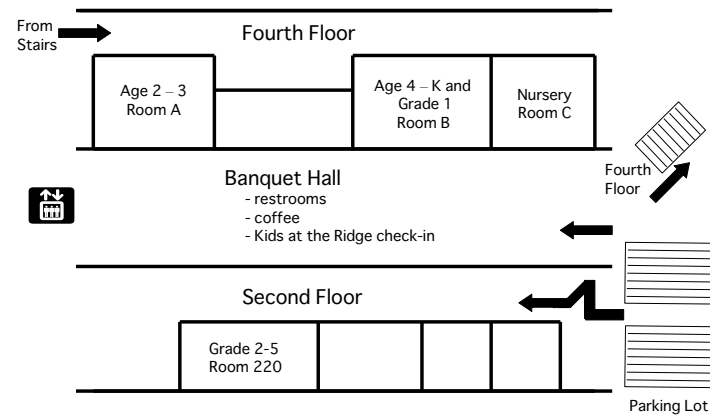

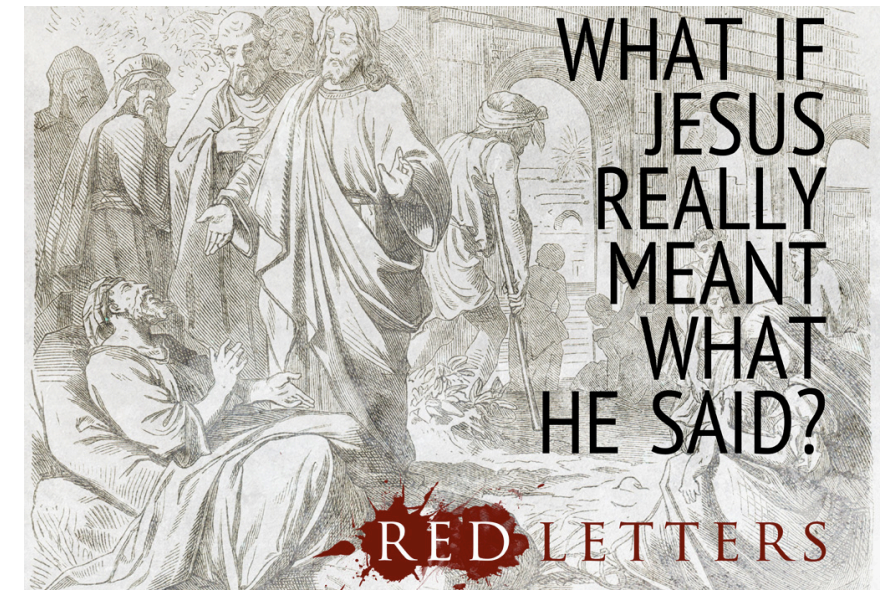
